In a matter of weeks, Esther will take what she's learned and put it to practice in a hospital setting. Practicums are typically 6-12 weeks, twice a year. It's valuable hands-on experience that will test Esther's skills and strength. She's nervous and excited at the same time!

As we cheer on Esther, let's reflect on the path that brought her here.

At an early age, Esther lost both of her parents. Her father died when she was 3 and her mother passed away when she was 8. A vulnerable young girl was left with her three brothers, two sisters and an aging, impoverished grandfather. Esther would carry the burden of making sure everyone's basic needs were met.

Fast-forward five years. Esther is 13 and welcomed into My Father's House Orphan Homes. She accepts Christ as her Lord and Savior and the transition is life changing. A family of sponsors surrounds her. They help to financially support her, pray for her, write her letters and tell her *she*

matters. Esther is given the opportunity to go to school and dream of God's purpose for her life.

And God's plan, with support from His people, has her at Apex University in Zambia studying Biology. She takes her seat among the 230 other students. Esther looks up at the chalkboard and reads:

Biology: the study of LIFE.

Her hands loosen their grip. Peace covers her like a warm blanket and she whispers another prayer, "I thank you Lord that I am not alone on this Journey, for you Lord—the **very author of LIFE**—you will guide my every step. Amen."
